



#### 1st Kings (part 2) Outline

Decline of David's (Solomon's) house (11-12).

- Jeroboam is called by God to be King of 10 tribes (Northern).
- Accession of Rehoboam
   (Solomon's heir) & folly (enslaves
   Hebrews).
- Israel divides.

The Divided Kingdoms (12-16).

Kings of Israel & Judah.

The Ministry of Elijah (17-22).

 Elijah v's King Ahab, Jezebel & The Prophets of Baal.

## The Northern Kingdom Israel/Samaria.

- Jeroboam sets up a parallel apostate religious system.
  - The Golden Calf cult (Baal imagery).
  - Non Levitical priesthood (Dan & Bethel).
  - Jeroboam is fearful that a single religious system
     (Yahweh's temple in Jerusalem) would reunite Israel &
     Judah, undermining his dynasty.
- Many faithful Yahweh worshippers move south.
- All Israel's kings 'do evil in the sight of God' (keep the 'Golden Calf' cult).

1st Kings & The Divided Monarchy

#### Israel's Kings

- Politically & Economically less stable than Judah.
- Israelite Kings reign avg. 10yrs.
- 9 different ruling dynasties took the throne.
- 7 Kings were assassinated, 1 struck by God (+1 suicide).
- Charisma, not ancestry (substance), guaranteed succession.
