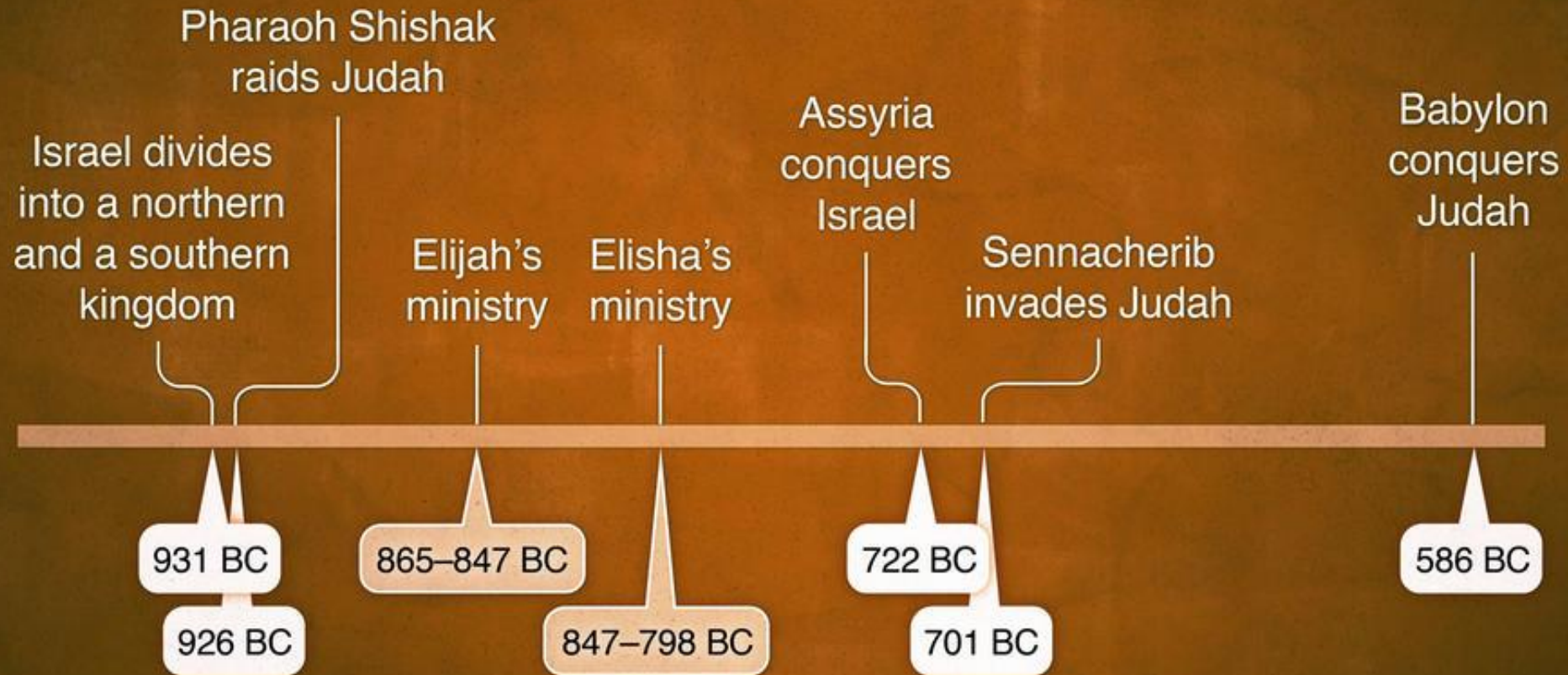

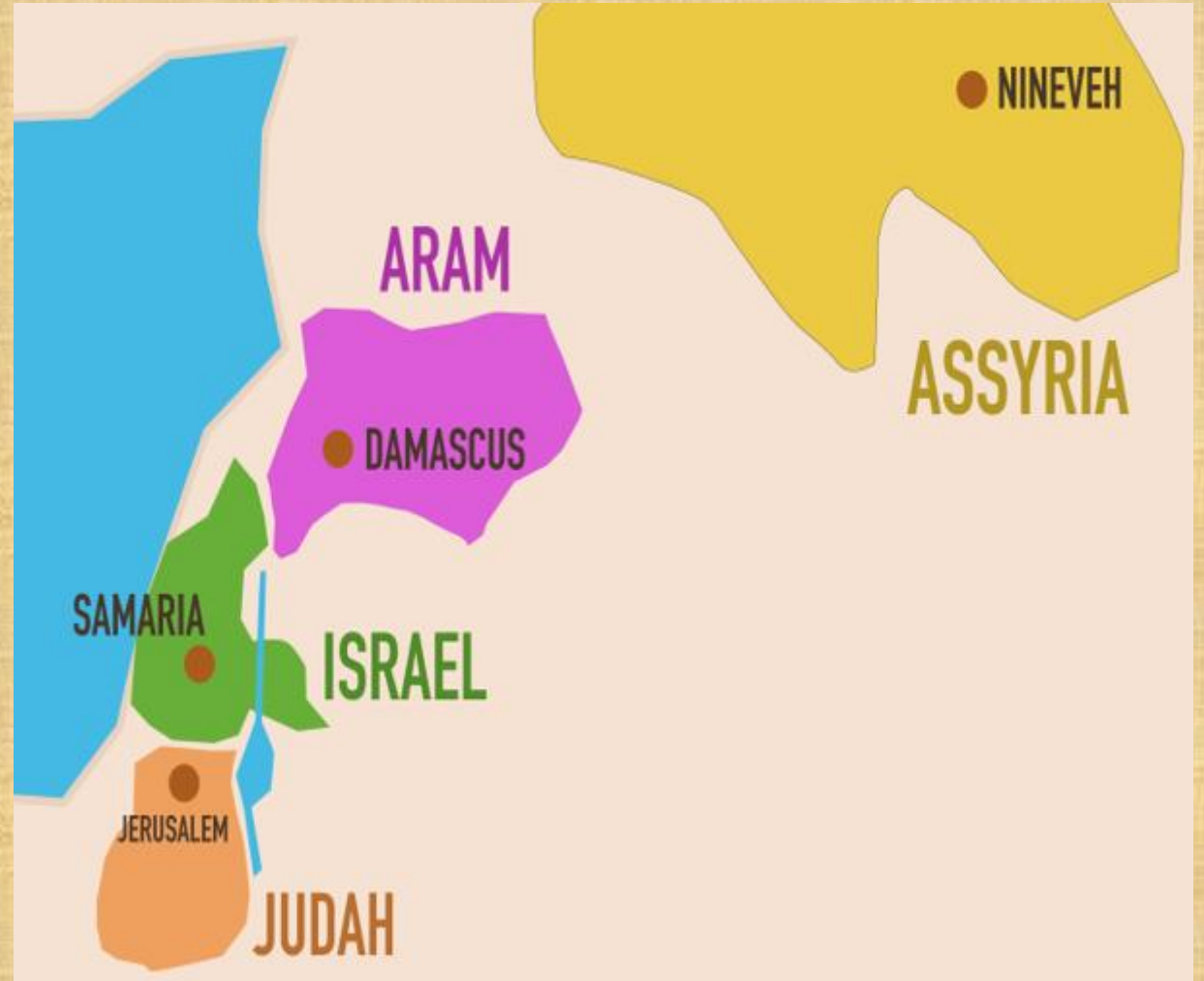

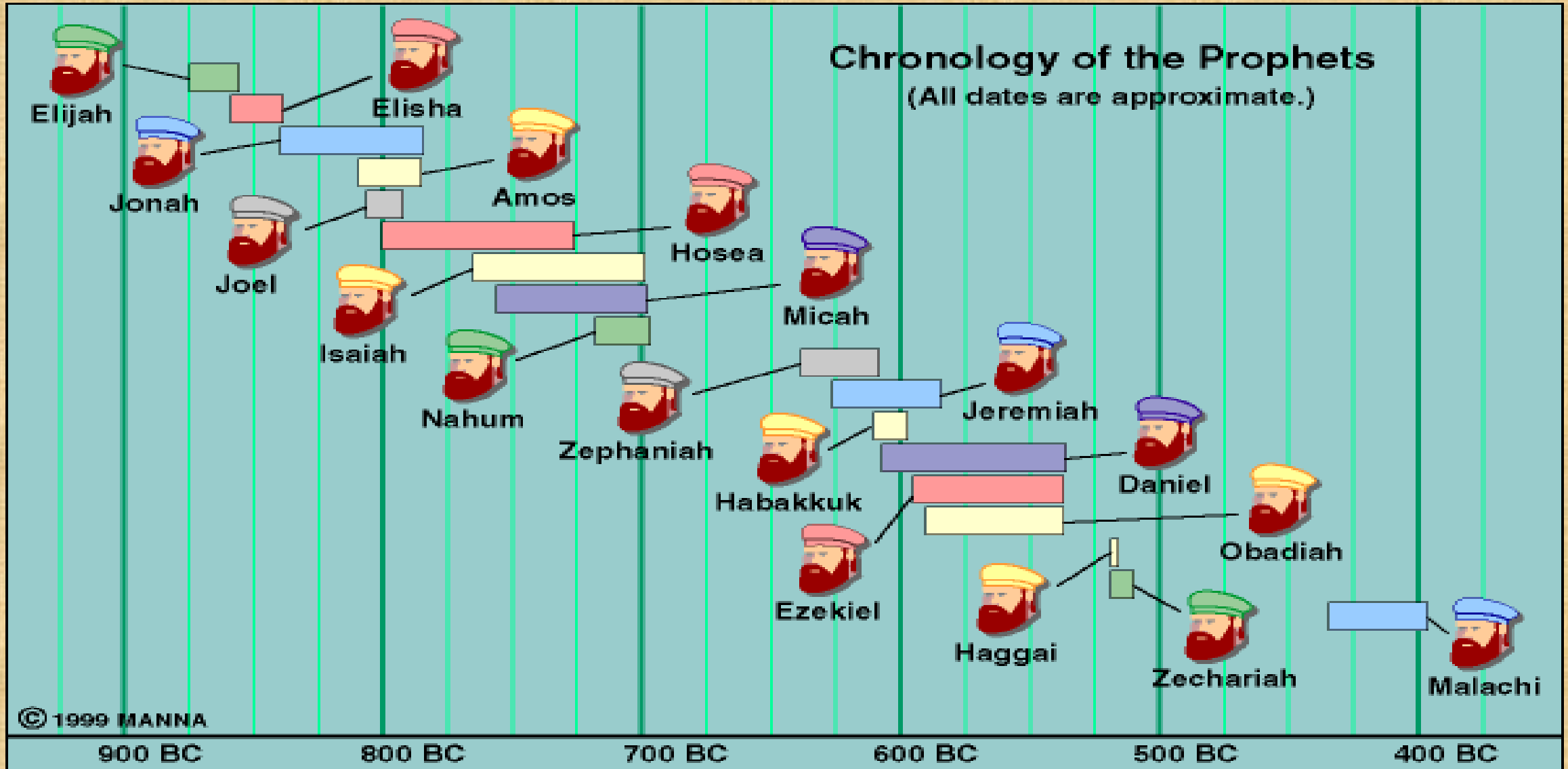
Israel's declension

- Rebellion with Egypt against Assyria.



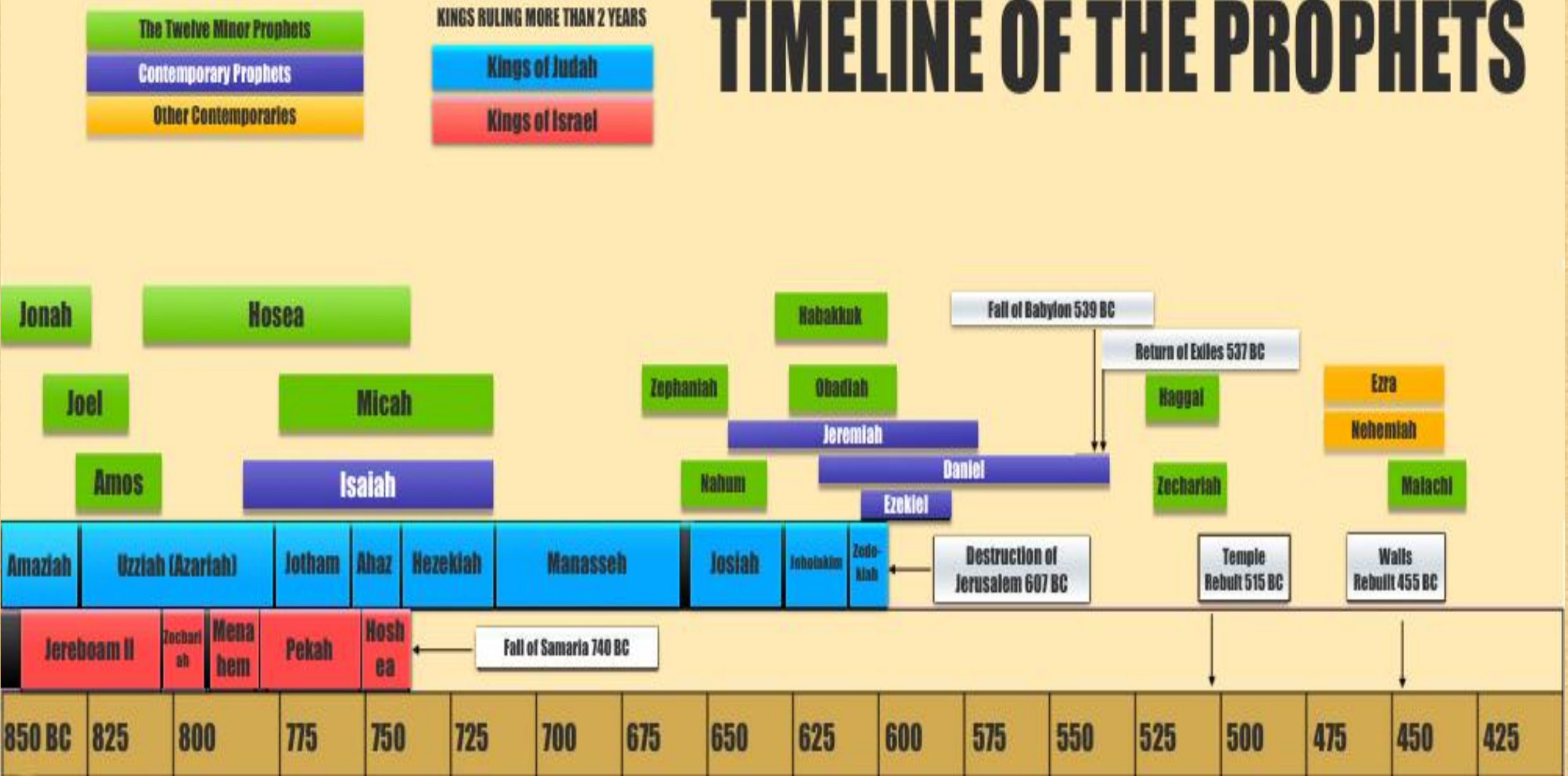

Key themes

- Israel should have been an example to the nations.
- God used Nineveh/Assyria to chastise Israel.
- Jonah begrudges Yahweh offering Assyria compassion if they repent.
- The Allegory of The Plant.
 - Jonah shows compassion on the plant, because it served his purposes.
 - God used Assyria for His purposes, shouldn't he show them compassion.
- Jonah as a type of The Messiah (sign to Israel/goes to gentiles).
- God desires to have compassion upon all.
