Key Themes

Judah's Covenant failure (according to the Mosaic Cov/Law).

- Their hopeless state, due to their internal depravity, idolatry & unrighteousness (mimicking the pagan nations) not due to external pressure, or provocation.

‘The Day of The Lord’ God’s inevitable judgement upon the wicked, including Israel, enacted upon Israel through the nations/Babylon, but then God’s judgement falls upon the pagan nations.

- Upon Israel, to wound, but thereby heal.
- Upon the nations, to cast down, destroy humiliate (the people + their gods).

Yahweh Judges the nations, through, and resulting from Him using them in His Judgement & Deliverance of Judah (His People).

Key Themes

‘The Lord of Hosts’ will redeem (a remnant of) His people (according to the Abrahamic Cov.).

- From their sinfulness, their oppressors, and even the righteous judgement of God, which they deserve.

The Holy One of Israel will still establish the Kingdom promises (Abraham/David) for Israel through/under His Davidic ‘Deliverer’.

- Who Will Save Judah?
- ‘The Lord of Hosts’, ‘The Holy One of Israel’ through His Davidic Deliverer.
 - The ‘Elect’ Suffering Servant.
 - The Anointed (Messianic/Christ) Conqueror.
 - The gentile King Cyrus (God’s anointed)?????
 - Salvation to ALL, ‘A light to the Gentiles’.
