


Zechariah's Main Theme

- A. Zechariah 1:7-11, 6:1-8 (God is not happy that Israel are not fulfilled).
- B. The Nations are 'at rest' (peace), Israel are 'at rest', as long as they <u>don't</u> pursue God's purposes for them (build God's Temple).
- C. This is a 'False Peace' as it is not 'From' God, and has not brought about God's purposes.
- D. God's purpose is to bring about the 'Fulfilment of Israel'.
- E. This 'False Peace' <u>Opposes</u> God's purposes, therefore GOD BRINGS TURMOIL.
- F. Revelation 6 Seals, 1 4, 'Take Peace' from 1/4 Earth.
- G. A 'Peace' must already exist/have been established upon the Earth (precede Seals 1-4).
 - i. Isaiah 28:15, John 11:48

Key Themes

Meaning of the Night Visions.

- 1. What Messiah will do.
 - Restore (Horsemen).
 - Rebuild (Craftsmen, measuring line).
 - Justify (Garments).
 - Sanctify (Lampstand).
 - Redeem (Scroll)
 - Remove Iniquity (Basket).
 - Establish Righteousness (Chariots/Crowns).

God's Agent of Change.

- 2. Who is The Messiah?
 - The 'Branch'
 - The 'Royal' High Priest.
 - Not 'of' The people (rebel).
 - Messiah is God.
 - 'Your' King (not a foreigner).
 - NOT The False Messiah.
 - The True Shepherd.
 - Lord of Destiny.
 - Purifier of Israel.
 - Kingsman Redeemer of Israel.
